




What are suprasegmentals?

 Such lexical stress is indicated by such properties as changes in pitch (pitch accent), increased intensity/loudness (dynamic accent) and full articulation of the vowel (qualitative accent) which refers to duration and vowel quality








Stressing the word

- Length duration
- Pitch high / low voice
- Intensity strong/weak, tense/lax (relax)
- Weaken others

- Affected by place and manner of articulation
- i.e. how you place tongue/mouth/teeth and breathing





- Content words are stressed
- 2 or more syllable words have one stressed/prominent syllable




