Important Vocabulary

Here are some important terms that are in the video

- **deception**-the act of deceiving someone, the act of hiding the truth
- **traitor**-a person who betrays someone or something
- **con-man**-a man who cheats or tricks someone by gaining their trust
- **manipulate**-to handle or control in a skillful manner
- **scheme**-to make plans, especially in a devious way
- **covertly**-without being openly acknowledged or displayed;secretly
- **concealment**-the action of hiding something or preventing it from being known
- **bluff**-an attempt to deceive someone into believing something
